What is Science Communication



Science communication is (Burns et al. 2003)

"The use of appropriate skills, media, activities and dialogue to produce one or more of the following personal responses to science

- Awareness
- Enjoyment
- Interest
- Opinion-forming
- Understanding"
 - → (AEIOU vowel analogy)

- Science communication addresses specifically the general public and lay audiences

Why Science Communication

- Ethic responsibility:
 - Scientific results affect everyone
 (just look at e.g., vaccines, internet, artificial intelligence, inflation, gender studies)
- Democratic societies are based on informed individuals
- Educated societies are more resilient


